The Trinity River Authority very much appreciates the continued loyalty and trust of visitors to our recreational facilities. With the uncertain and evolving health situation in the U.S., our highest priority is the health and well-being of our visitors and employees.

As we continue to follow Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommended guidelines, we ask our visitors to do the same. As of Monday, March 11, all park campsites and facilities are open at 100%.

Only MasterCard or Visa Credit/Debit Card payment will be accepted.

Although Wolf Creek Park outdoor spaces are very effective at increasing the social distancing recommended by health professionals, everyone must remain diligent in following the CDC recommended preventative actions to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. Please inform a park staff member if you have any safety concerns while you are visiting a park.

Here's how you can help:

- Be diligent to properly dispose of refuse and tightly secure trash bags for park staff to pick up.
- If you have been sick in the last two weeks, please stay at home for your health and the safety of others.
- If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 after visiting Wolf Creek Park, please notify the park immediately.
